It is matter of great pleasure for all of us that the High power committee constituted by Govt. of Odisha on D 01.03.2019 has been kind enough allowed 5 years integrated BA.LLB (Hons) with 90 intake capacity to Khordha Law College and also introduction of post graduate in Law is under way.

Course: 5 Year Integrated BA LLB (Hons.)

The idea to introduce specialized five years integrated Law Course originated at All India Law Ministers and Secretary's conference held on 24th of September 1995 at Bhubaneswar. In response to the resolution of the said conference, the Utkal University started five years integrated BALL.B (Hons). Since 2014-15 Academic session the choice Based Credit System has been introduced in the 5 Years integrated BA.LL.B (Hons) course.

To monitor this specialized course a High power committee has been constituted with a sitting Judge of the Hon'ble High-Court of Odisha as its chairman along with the vice chancellor of Utkal University, chairman of state Bar Council, representative of Bar Council of India, teachers and other officers of Utkal University as its members. The curriculum is prescribed by the Bar Council of India and the University Grants commission, New Delhi.

The course is as per with the syllabus prescribed by the Utkal University/and law schools in India offering five year integrated B.A.LL.B (Hons) programme in Law.

1. Students strength

The duration of the BA.LL.B course is 5 years and each year comprises of 2 semesters. The total number of seats is 90.

2. Eligibility requirement

A candidate shall be eligible for admission in to 5 years BA LL.B (Hons) course if she/he has passed +2 Examination (at least 10, +2 pattern) securing a minimum of 45% marks in aggregate for General and 40% marks for (SC/ST).

3. Such students prior to seeking admission in to 5 yrs. integrated course should not have passed any other examination higher than 10, +2 Examination.

4. In case of seats allocated for filling up form SC/ST category. In case of non-availability of candidates in one of this category, seats will be filled up from candidates of other category.

5. 3% of the total numbers seats will be reserved for physically handicapped students at the time of the admission. In case of non-availability the seats will be filled up from the general category of students.

6. Age:

Maximum 21 yrs for general category students and 22 years for SC & ST.

7. Application Procedure

7.1 Candidate seeking admission in to 5 years BA. LL.B (Hons) Degree course shall apply in the prescribed form obtainable from the office of the principal, Khordha Law College on payment of Rs. 500/- (Rupees five hundred) only in cash or by post by sending Bank draft of Rs. 600/- (Rupees six hundred) only drawn in favour of Principal, Khordha Law College. Candidate shall write full name on the back of the Bank Draft. Application forms can be downloaded from the College website www.khordhalawcollege.com.

7.2 The application form duly filled in by the candidate shall reach the office of Principal, Khordha Law College, Khordha on or before the last date declared by the college. The forms can be submitted either by person or by post. The Khordha Law College will not be held liable for any postal delay.

The following documents are to be attached along with the Application form.

- i. Attested copy of HSCE or equivalent certificate & Mark sheet.
- ii. Attested copy of CHSE or equivalent +2/Intermediate certificate & Mark sheet.
- iii. Attested copy of conduct certificate from the educational institution last attend.
- iv. Attested copy of Caste Certificate in case of SC/ST category.
- v. In case of Handicap applicant attested copy of certificate from competent authority must be attached.
- vi. Four passport size colour photographs (2.5 cm x 3.5 cm) signed by the applicant candidate
- vii. Two self- addressed envelope size 12” x 5”
- viii. Original money receipt of the application form.

8. Selection Procedure for Admission

Selection of the students shall be made strictly on the basis of career-cum-entrance. With the following break-up of marks:-

9. Dress Code

Student shall wear formal dress as follows:

1. For male Students:- white/Black trouser, white shirt, black tie, black coat, white socks, black leather covered shoe.
2. For female Students: white /Black Trouser/Salwar, white shirt/kurta, black tie/dupatta, black coat, black/white socks, blaeth shoe.
3. Optional for girl students: Black/white printed sari, white full sleeved blouse, black covered shoe.

10. Rules for Library

1. A Library card will be issued to each bonafide student on production of money receipt and valid ID.
2. Library books are not transferable and books will not be issued on behalf of another student.
3. No students should entry the library without showing the ID & signing in the visitor's register.
4. Students are required to produce their ID, library card at the time of library transaction.
5. Any personal books, bags and umbrella should not be brought into the library.
6. Students should return the library books, borrowed by them before their forms for each semester examination.
7. The following privileges are applicable for users under different categories.
All students: 2 books for 14 days
Teaching faculty: 5 books for 14 days
A fine of Rs 2.00 per book will charged for each day of delay.
8. If a book is lost or damaged by a borrower, he/she has to pay ten times the price of the book or replace/return it with a new edition of the book.

11. Attendance required

If any student falls short of 75% of attendance he/she shall not be allowed to sit in the examination.

(Applicable for every Semester of the BA.LLB Course)

12. Examination

All examination are conducted according to the Regulations relating to the BA.LL.B (5 years) course formed by the Utkal University.

13. Common Rooms

A separate common room for girl & boys, which may be used by the students for recreation, discussion and socializing with other fellow students.

14. Seminar Hall

A separate class cum seminar hall for organizing seminar, conference etc.

15. Canteen

A canteen for the student & the staff.

16. Placement cell

Placement cell which will help the student in getting jobs in the various fields.

17. Legal Aid clinic

18. Course Fee

Fee for BA.LL.B (Hons.) course shall be as prescribed by the college from time to time

19. Grievance Cell:

The students can meet the principal to redress their grievance in the grievance cell, which meets once in a month

20. Hostel:

KLC is providing hostel facility to the male and female students.
